The Shamrock Scavenger Hunt started on February 17 and runs through March 17.

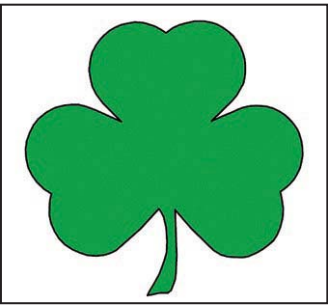
Businesses will display a Shamrock Scavenger Hunt Participating Business poster and have a shamrock or shamrock display in their business.

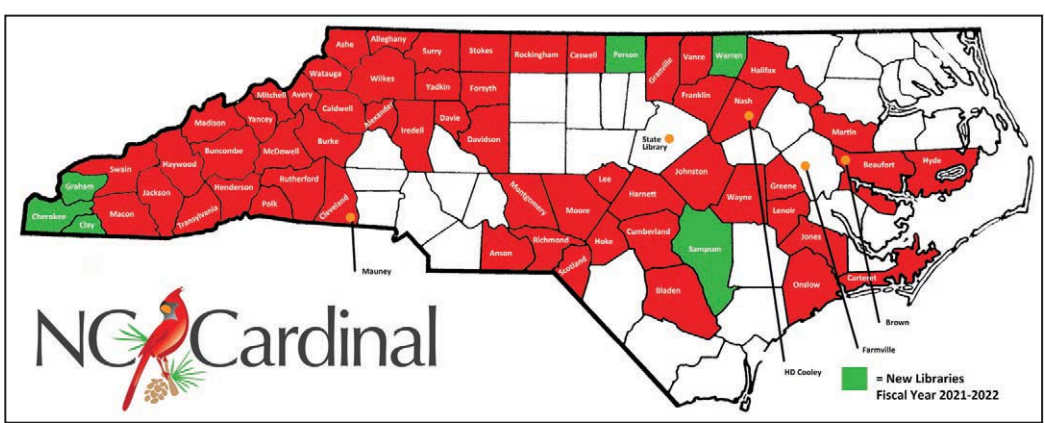

State Library welcomes AMY Regional Library System to NC Cardinal Library Consortium

The NC Cardinal Library Consortium has connected public libraries in more than 50 counties across the state that share resources through a single online catalog and system-wide borrowing privileges.

The Avery-Mitchell-Yancey Regional Library system officially joined NC Cardinal in February, giving residents of those counties access to over 7 million books.

"On behalf of our library employees, board members, and patrons, I'm elated about the opportunity for our library system to join NC Cardinal," said Amber Westall-Briggs, director of the AMY Regional Library system.
