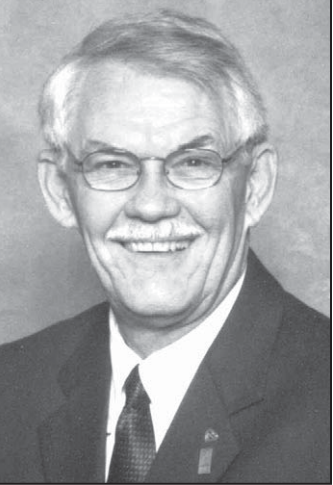
Johnnie Robinson
