His business was a popular place for visits, where everyone was fair game for his practical jokes. Albert had a sharp, quick wit, and always had a joke or one-liner ready to spring on his friends. He was also quick to help others, but never wanted recognition for his generosity.

While he was a successful businessman, his proudest accomplishment was his family. Throughout his life, he often said, "I am so blessed to have my family." His children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren were his pride and joy. Repeating anecdotes about their childhoods never grew old. Albert faithfully attended Windom United Methodist Church and enjoyed Sunday afternoon rides in his convertible with Eloise, taking his family to the beach, and on every possible occasion, having a house full of people who loved him.
