Yancey County WIC Program-Services and Hours

The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children, WIC, is a federal assistance program for:

- women who are pregnant, have had a baby in the last six months, are breastfeeding an infant under 12 months,
- infants and/or children up to 5 years of age.

The WIC program provides supplemental nutritious foods, nutrition education, breastfeeding support and referrals to health care and community resources to program participants.

Yancey County WIC program has new hours which are 8:30 am - 5:00 pm. We continue to modify how services are provided. WIC services continue to be offered over the phone through federal waivers but can also be in person. If you have a scheduled appointment, a WIC staff will contact you to conduct your appointment over the phone, make your WIC benefits available and schedule your next WIC appointment. If you would like to apply for WIC that can also be completed by phone. Plans for returning to in-person appointments, will be reviewed in Jan. 2023. To be eligible for WIC a person must also:

- live in North Carolina;
- meet the income eligibility scale (see chart below). Families participating in SNAP, Medicaid or NC Health Choice are automatically income eligible.
