Spriggly's Insect Exploration Station opens at Asheville Museum of Science

Spriggly's Beescaping is pleased to announce the installation of their Insect Exploration Station at the Asheville Museum of Science.

Spriggly's Insect Exploration Station offers a new experience to support the dynamic exhibits and engaging programming at the Asheville Museum of Science.

The Station is a rotating exhibit space featuring a series of interactive installations focused on the fascinating world of insects.

Currently featured is the exhibit "How Native Bees Prepare For Winter," which includes a series of informational signage, a larger than life model of the inside of a mason bee nest, and an interactive "Build like a Bee" game for children of all ages.

The informational signage on display as part of the exhibit features a hand-painted tree stump with the many species of bees that can nest in and around standing dead trees.

Also on display is a selection of high-resolution scientific specimen images from the USGS Bee Inventory and Survey.

Each native bee image is partnered with a series of easy to remember facts about these extremely efficient pollinators. Patrons have the opportunity to expand their knowledge on common bees native to North America, which do not include the European honey bee.

Spriggly's Beescaping is a small business that works with museums, municipalities, and more to increase environmental awareness through educational exhibits and experiences.

Their work focuses on pollinators, conservation efforts, and a general appreciation of nature. The Asheville Museum of Science (AMOS) on Patton Avenue is known as the premier exploratory science experience in downtown Asheville.

With fully interactive exhibits, street-level access, and a variety of educational programs, AMOS is a perfect destination for the entire family.

Spriggly's Insect Exploration Station will be on display at AMOS all year, rotating quarterly to a new insect exhibit focus.

"How Native Bees Prepare for Winter" will be on display until the end of November, with the next exhibit opening mid-December.

The Asheville Museum of Science is open Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday from 1 - 5 p.m.

Admission to the Museum of Science includes Spriggly's Insect Exploration Station and is \$7 for adults, \$6 for children, military, and students with valid I.D., and free for children 2 and under.
