Flynn gets \$20,000 Fellowship

Michael Seth Flynn, of Burnsville, has been selected as a recipient of a Marcus L. Urann Fellowship by the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi.

This is the nation's oldest and most selective collegiate honor society for all academic disciplines.

Flynn is one of only six recipients nationwide to receive the prestigious \$20,000 fellowship, named for the Society's founder.

Flynn received a bachelor's degree in biology and chemistry from University of North Carolina at Charlotte. As a Urann Fellow, Flynn will pursue a Doctor

of Medicine at Duke University School of Medicine.

Since its creation in 1932, the Fellowship Program has become one of the Society's most visible and financially well-supported endeavors, allocating \$615,000 annually to outstanding students for first-year graduate or professional study.

This year's program awarded 50 fellowships of \$8,500, six \$20,000 Marcus L. Urann Fellowships, named for the Society's founder, and two new awards at \$35,000 each, the 1897 Fellowship and the Sherrill Carlson Fellowship.

Community Foundation awards scholarships to Mtn. Heritage students

The Community Foundation of Western North Carolina recently approved scholarships totaling \$587,000 to 99 students in 57 schools in 22 counties in

Western North Carolina. Sixty volunteers from the community worked to review applications and select recipients.

Carrie Brake and Devin Street from Mountain Heritage High School were awarded CFWNC scholarships.

Scholarship endowments can have broad eligibility criteria or can be focused on a particular school or county, offered to students pursuing a degree in a stated field or available to those who will attend a designated college or university.

"It is a privilege to work with students, counselors and volunteers from all over Western North Carolina," said Scholarship Officer Lezette Parks. "I would not be able to do my job well without their help. These awards are an investment in the future."

Community Foundation of WNC (CFWNC) works with families, businesses and nonprofits to strengthen communities through the creation of charitable funds and strategic grantmaking.

A permanent charitable resource, the foundation manages over 1,100 funds and facilitated \$20 million in grants last year bringing total giving to more than \$254 million since its founding in 1978.
