Pain and stress can often lead people down the path of substance use, as they turn to prescription opioids or other substances in an attempt to find relief.

Though substances may dull the pain or stress for a time, more and more must be taken to continue the feeling of relief, which can eventually lead to addiction.

Thankfully, local residents have the opportunity to take part in a free initiative that helps to address the needs of the whole person through safe and effective pain and stress management techniques.

Home Remedies: Community Options Addressing Pain and Stress is hosted by Partners Aligned Toward Health and the Mitchell-Yancey Substance Abuse Task Force through a grant from the NC Department of Health and Human Services and partnership with VAYA Health.

Coming in February, Home Remedies classes will showcase complementary medical practices like massage therapy, tai chi, chair yoga, health coaching and resiliency tools. All classes begin with a mindfulness practice and include active

Voters will not be required to show photo ID when they vote in the primary election on March 3, 2020. In a December 31 order, a federal district court blocked North Carolina's voter photo ID requirement from taking effect. The injunction will remain in place until further order of the court.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on the day of the election, Tuesday, March 3. One-stop early voting will be held at the YANCEY Board of Elections office. One-stop early voting will be open from 8:30 am Thursday, February 13 until 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 29.

Canvass will be held in the YANCEY Board of Elections office at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, March 13.

Absentee voting by mail is available. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made on an absentee request form (available on the State Board of Elections website and at the county board of elections office), and must be received in the YANCEY Board of Elections office or any one-stop early voting site by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 25. Completed request forms may only be returned in-person to the YANCEY Board of Elections by the voter, the voter's near relative or verifiable legal guardian, or by a Multipartisan Assistance Team, or delivered by the U.S. Postal Service or designated delivery service (DHL, FedEx, or UPS). Absentee voting requires the voter to complete an application on the return envelope that must be witnessed by two qualified persons or a notary public. Completed absentee ballots must be returned to the YANCEY Board of Elections by 5:00 p.m. on Election Day (ballots received by mail after this time will be timely if received within three business days and postmarked by Election Day). Voters may receive assistance voting a mail-in absentee ballot from a near relative or verifiable legal guardian, or by a qualified person of their choice if a near relative or legal guardian is not available. If the voter lives in a facility such as a nursing home, and the voter's near relative or legal guardian is not available, the voter or the facility can arrange to have the county board of elections schedule a visit by a Multipartisan Assistance Team to provide assistance and serve as witnesses.

All persons who are registered to vote with the YANCEY Board of Elections may vote in this election.

In a partisan primary, voters who are affiliated with a political party may only vote in their party's primary and on any nonpartisan contests. Unaffiliated voters may choose to participate in the Democratic, Libertarian, or Republican primary or if available, may vote a nonpartisan ballot. Unaffiliated voters may not vote in the Constitution Party or Green Party primary.

Persons who are not already registered to vote in the county must register by Friday, February 7 to be eligible to vote in this election. Voters who are not registered in the county by that deadline may register and vote during onestop early voting only and will be required to provide documentation of their identity and residence. Voters who wish to change party affiliation or who have changed name or address must do so by the registration deadline. Voters who fail to timely make a change in name or address in the county must update the information when presenting to vote and may be required to vote a provisional ballot.

Voters voting in person are entitled to assistance by an election official, or, if assistance is needed due to disability or illiteracy, by a qualified person of their choice. Voting sites are accessible to all voters. Curbside voting is available for voters who are not able to enter voting sites.

The following is a list of Yancey County polling places and a description of each buffer zone in which Election Day electioneering is allowed. Buffer zones are designated in accordance with G.S. § 163-166.4(a), by the county board of elections. Where practical set limit of the zone is 50 feet from the door of entrance to the voting place, measured when that door is closed, but in no event is the limit at more than 50 feet or at less than 25 feet.

The poll workers will mark buffer zones on Election Day with No Campaigning or Electioneering signs.

Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the side entrance door

Green Mountain: Located at Green Mountain Voting House

Jacks Creek: Located at Clearmont Elementary School
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the back entrance

Brush Creek: Located at the Brush Creek Community Building
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the front door

Crabtree: Located at New Dale Fire Station
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the front door

South Toe: Located at South Toe Elementary School
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the back entrance

Pensacola: Located at Pensacola Fire Department
Electioneering is allowed 50 ft from the side entrance
