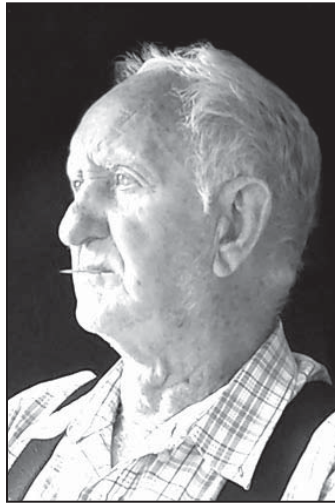
## Vera Louise Angel Garland

The Town of Burnsville had a discharge of untreated wastewater from our wastewater collection system at the intersection of East Main St. and US 19E Bypass of approximately 6,000 gallons. The discharge occurred on April 22, 2020 for approximately 7 hours. The untreated wastewater entered into Little Crabtree Creek in the French Broad River Basin.
